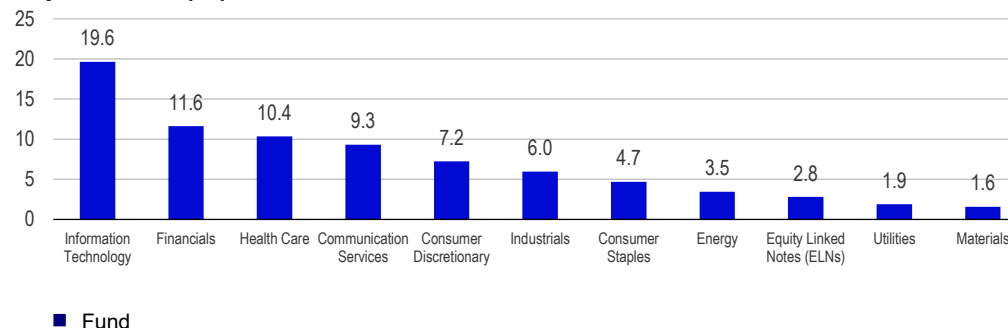
What this fund does
